Goals of Sanctuary Renewal

In Worship:

- + Bring pastor closer to the congregation with moveable altar and lectern.
- + Feature the baptismal font more prominently as a symbol of our continual renewal as people of God.
- + Enhance the music program by moving musicians and organ to the front of the sanctuary to better lead hymns and support worship services.

In Welcome:

- + Develop a more welcoming environment overall – from the first steps into the narthex and continuing into the sanctuary.
- + Create a space that serves the needs of all three services and welcomes members back “home.”
- + Foster a comfortable, inviting environment for visitors.
- + Develop a space which is nonthreatening and engaging for even young children to approach the front.
- + Construct more accessible paths for people of varying mobility.
- + Update restrooms to be more attractive and fully accessible.
- + Revitalize sound systems so all may hear the message.
- + Proactively remove potentially hazardous ceiling materials before issues arise.

In Service:

- + Gain ability to modify seating arrangement and flow to allow more creative expressions of worship, including children serving the Gospel in drama, dance, and music.
- + Transform the space to *renew the people*, so Trinity truly is a place where all are inspired to go out and serve.
